The Plaintiffs have attached a supporting memorandum, several declarations, and a proposed order.

The Plaintiffs request an expedited oral hearing pursuant to LCvR 65.1.(d), given that the violations outlined in this motion are ongoing and that absent an injunction, the Plaintiffs will be (1) precluded from obtaining information from the Council in a timely fashion, (2) forced to continue diverting resources to respond to the Council, and (3) prevented from being represented by the Council, all of which result in irreparable harm.
